SUPPLEMENTAL ANNOUNCEMENT
DISCLOSEABLE AND CONNECTED TRANSACTION
RELATING TO
INVESTMENT IN CONCERT

Reference is made to the announcement of EDICO Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”) dated 6 March 2026 (the “**Announcement**”) in relation to the joint investment with StarMac Entertainment & Production Limited in respect of its 10% co-organizer interest in a concert. Unless the context requires otherwise, capitalised terms used in this announcement shall have the same meaning as those defined in the Announcement.

The Company wishes to provide the Shareholders and potential investors with further information in relation to the transactions contemplated under the Concert Joint Investment Agreement.

BASIS OF DETERMINATION OF THE INVESTMENT SUM

The total costs and expenses of the Concert are budgeted at HK\$78,000,000, comprising artist performance fee, media promotion, photography and videography, staff, insurance, supplies and miscellaneous expenditures. The budget was determined by the Organizer (which owns the majority stake in the Concert) and was presented to StarMac and Voice Production on arm’s length commercial terms. The artist performance fee, which accounts for the largest component the total budget, represents the fee agreed between the Organizer and the artist’s representative on arm’s length terms, and therefore reflects normal commercial terms. The remaining cost items represent standard operational expenditures customarily incurred in connection with a large-scale concert. Having considered the foregoing, the Directors are of the view that the basis of determination of the total budget is fair and reasonable and on normal commercial terms.

It is the intention of the Group to maintain the committed sum for any individual entertainment program or event within HK\$7,500,000 so as to preserve a liquidity buffer for its core financial printing business and to manage risk prudently. Given the intended level of commitment and StarMac’s retention of a residual economic stake in the Co-organizer Interest as contractual co-organizer under the Concert Agreement (aligning its incentives with the Concert’s performance and risk profile), Voice Production and StarMac mutually agreed on a 96:4 sharing ratio of economic benefits and costs derived from the Co-organizer Interest.

The Investment Sum was settled by the internal resources of the Group.

INFORMATION OF THE ORGANIZER

Pursuant to the Concert Agreement, the Organizer is responsible for hosting the Concert and it has final decision-making authority and control over all relevant matters of the Concert.

The Organizer is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Kwan's International Co., Ltd, which is a company listed on the Taipei Exchange (stock code: 6101) principally engaged in the cultural and creative business. According to the latest publicly available information, the single largest shareholder of Kwan's International Co., Ltd is Chiu Han-Chung, who serves as the chairman and president, holding approximately 12.3% in Kwan's International Co., Ltd as of March 2026. To the best of the knowledge, information and belief of the Directors having made all reasonable enquiries, the Organizer and its ultimate beneficial owners are third parties independent of the Company and its connected persons.

REASONS FOR AND BENEFITS OF THE ENTERING INTO OF THE CONCERT JOINT INVESTMENT AGREEMENT

In assessing the commercial viability of the investment, the executive committee of the Board has taken into account (i) the actual ticket sales performance achieving full ticket sell-out, which substantiates the basis of the projected revenue; and (ii) the irrevocable warranty and undertaking from StarMac to refund the entire Investment Sum, which effectively mitigates financial exposure and preserves the Company's invested capital regardless of the financial outcome of the Concert.
